Documents Verification

Our admissions team will review the original documents provided by the parents to verify their authenticity and completeness.

In case of any discrepancies or missing information, parents will be asked for further clarification.

If our admission team feel satisfy will take consent of parents for start of Registration Process.

After confirmation from parents our team will take photo copies of all the original document and all originals will be returned to the parents.

Registration

The Registration Process will start after the payment of prescribed registration fee by any designated mode of payment.

After confirmation of the payment of registration fee a Registration Form will be issued and parents will require to submit the duly completed & signed Registration Form along with self-attested copies of all the

documents at present they have.

Interview Process

After completion of the Registration process an interview of student & their parents will be taken by the principal or coordinator. During the Interview an opportunity will also be provided to the student & their parents for healthy discussion.

Entrance Examination

On the basis of interview, the principal may recommend for Written Test.

The test may be taken on same day or on any other date convenient to student & their parents & result will be declared within one hour after completion of the test.

Admission Decision

Results from the entrance examination and interview will be evaluated holistically & final decision will be taken on the basis of overall performance and attitudes shown by the student & their parents.
